Several Club members met at the Gemeente Museum on 17 August to visit the much-publicised De Stijl exhibition. Seen as an extension to the exhibition on Mondrian's life and work, De Stijl put into focus the enormous innovations that were taking place at the beginning of the 20th century in the world of design and architecture. An extremely informative guide with a sense of drama enhanced our morning, which finished with a visit to the mock-up of Mondrian's studio: all straight lines, not a curve in sight, functional and calm.
